The award is \$750 for the 2024-2025 academic year. Completed applications must be submitted or postmarked no later than May 1, 2024; the award winner will be notified soon thereafter.

Eligibility Requirements and Application Instructions

Complete applications **must** include the following:

- A completed application form including applicant signature (and parent/guardian signature for applicants under 18 years of age)
- High school transcript (H.S. seniors & current college freshmen/sophomores)
- Current college transcript (college students)
- Proof of acceptance to an accredited college or university (high school seniors)
- Two letters of recommendation (not to be from family members)
- An essay of approximately 250-500 words as described in the application

Eligibility requirements:

- Applicant must be a high school senior and/or pursuing post-secondary education in the fall in which the application is made.
- Applicant's home residence must be in the area served by the Memphis Chapter of the AMS/NWA (generally a 125-mile radius around Memphis, Tennessee).
- Applicant must expect to be enrolled in multiple classes in the upcoming school year (i.e., award not to be used for an individual correspondence course).
