The Memphis Chapter of the American Meteorological Society/National Weather Association provides this scholarship to a deserving student in order to promote continuing education in the atmospheric sciences and/or meteorology and to provide encouragement to that student in his or her pursuit of a degree in atmospheric sciences. The award is \$500 for the 2021-2022 academic year. Completed applications must be submitted or postmarked no later than May 16, 2021; the award winner will be notified in June.

Eligibility Requirements and Application Instructions

Complete applications **must** include the following:

- A completed application form including applicant signature (and parent/guardian signature for applicants under 18 years of age)
- High school transcript (H.S. seniors & current college freshmen/sophomores)
- Current college transcript (college students)
- Proof of acceptance to an accredited college or university (high school seniors)
- Two letters of recommendation (not to be from family members)
- An essay of approximately 250 words as described in the application

Eligibility requirements:

- Applicant must be a high school senior and/or pursuing post-secondary education in the fall in which the application is made.
- Applicant's home residence must be in the area served by the Memphis Chapter of the AMS/NWA (generally a 125-mile radius around Memphis, Tennessee).
- Applicant must expect to be enrolled in multiple classes in the upcoming school year (i.e., award not to be used for an individual correspondence course).
